# PROJECT OVERVIEW

After Hurricane Katrina the Superdome needed to be completely restored. Doug Thornton, VP, SMG, determined that all carpet on the access ramps and concourses be replaced with a flexible, waterproof epoxy floor. With only 3 months before the first New Orleans Saints football game, the experienced team organized by PolySpec LP was chosen to install 350,000 square feet of decorative quartz flooring.

### KEY CONSIDERATIONS

**Decorative Quartz:** Multiple custom PolySpec Color Quartz Blends were chosen to update, and enhance the floors throughout the Superdome. PolySpec blended 175 tons of color quartz to meet the desired needs of the Superdome project team.

Excessive damage to ramps & concourses: The floors were excessively damaged by the carpet removal process leaving the floors with unusually deep grooves and vacuities. The PolySpec double broadcast decorative quartz system was modified to include a epoxy slurry coat designed specifically to resurface the entire floor prior to installation of the PolySpec system.
